### **Installing and configuring Zend PHP Server for IBM i**

The presentation will include a live demo on how to install and configure Zend Server on a System i. The presentation will include the following topics and much more:

- Installation of Zend Core
- Configuration of Zend Studio to work with your environment
- Verification of your Core installation with Hello World and tour of IFS
- Verification of access to database by listing items in a library.
- The presentation will include demo of lightweight community edition and will discuss the full version.

Zend Server will come in two flavors: a full version and a lightweight community edition (Zend Server CE). CE is a no-charge LP and is comparable to Core. The full version is like getting Core and Platform all in one LP. Zend Server is the next generation. Core and Platform will be discontinued. The GA date has not been set yet but is anticipated for first quarter 2010.

## **About the Speaker:**

Mike Pavlak has been working with IBM midrange solutions since 1992 and IBM Mainframes before that. After years of developing applications using RPG, CL and PHP he managed IT development and IT for power protection manufacturer Tripp Lite. Recently, Mike has joined Zend as a Solutions Consultant working with the i5 sales team and spreading the news about Zend solutions in the IBM midrange arena.
