## Node.js Crash Course

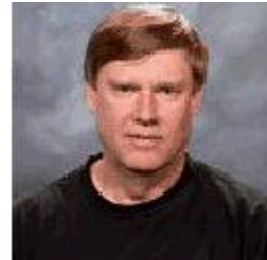
