Overview:

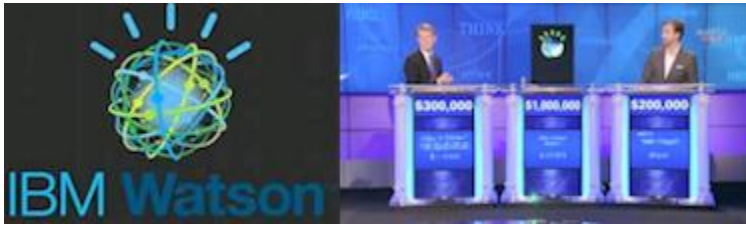
