### Overview:

IBM i services provided by Db2 for i can be used to access system information that is useful for developers. In the past you may have considered using CL or coding to system APIs to access and work with some system information. Today there is a better option: SQL. I will show you how to use SQL to work with data areas and data queues, discover how easy it is to review your program and service program attributes, read and write to the IFS, and more.
